

Dear Valued Guest,

The Western Cape is currently experiencing a water crisis. As a result, the City of Cape Town municipality has implemented **Level 6B water restrictions**.

Level 6B water restrictions require all water users to use **NO MORE THAN 50 LITRES / 13 GALLONS** of municipal drinking water per person per day **IN TOTAL**, irrespective of whether you are at home, work, or elsewhere.

We are asking all guests to please be extra cautious when using water whilst in our region. It is for this reason we have **removed the bath plugs, and ask that you please shower**. Should you have a condition that requires you to bath please do not hesitate to contact the Duty Manager by dialing extension 9.

Your bed linen and bath towels are freshly laundered for your arrival. Historically, our standard was to change bed linen and bath towels every second day and again after check-out. **In light of the water crisis, your bed linen and bath towels will only be changed upon request during your stay.**

Due to the water restrictions please note that during this period our **swimming pool will not be operational**.

We thank you for your understanding and for contributing to our water saving efforts.
